#### **Module Content**

#### **Outline Syllabus**

One-to-one hour long instrumental and vocal lessons are delivered weekly. Vocal repertory and improvisation workshops support student projects. Project rehearsals are supported by tutors. Preproduction sessions and performances provide opportunity for formative feedback.

#### **Module Overview**

Building upon and applying skills and technique from Level 4 and 5 modules, students are required to plan, execute and evaluate performance led projects over the course of the year, leading to a final performance.
