

VISITING PROFESSIONALS/ LECTURERS

We have already established strong links with the arts and entertainment industry.

Throughout our programmes, we aim to supplement the work of our permanent staff with Visiting Professionals active within the industry who are interested in passing on their skills and experience to our students.

In order to ensure we are able to draw from the widest pool of expertise available we invite applications on an on-going basis.

Candidates should have considerable professional experience in the appropriate field. Teaching experience and a relevant degree would be an advantage but are not essential.

<u>A Flexible Commitment</u>

We will be inviting Visiting Professionals to work with students for one-off sessions as well as for extended projects and whole modules.

Your commitment is thus likely to be very flexible and could be built around your other commitments.

Conditions

The rate of pay for teaching on our HE programmes during the current year (2021/2022) is £44.11 per hour, inclusive of holiday pay.

In some cases (e.g. for extended performance projects), fees may be negotiated which consolidate this rate.

In general, we will require Visiting Professionals to attend team meetings and become involved in assessment and planning. Where this involves a significant amount of additional attendance at LIPA then an additional allowance may be payable for these extra commitments.

Visiting Professionals will be able to access our staff training and development programmes where it is appropriate to their involvement and we will offer induction sessions at the beginning of each term.

Work spaces are allocated in the building for Visiting staff.
