## Module Content

Outline Syllabus
<p>The module will introduce the student to factors that are required by film and TV production.</p> <p>Script breakdowns, schedules, crew lists, risk assessments and other relevant documentation will be created from source material and discussed through the reverse engineering of existing productions. Practical production situations, sessions and time management, health and safety and professional working practices will also be considered.</p> <p>Computer-based skills, desktop research and other techniques will be presented and industry standard packages will be used as tools for aiding productions.</p>
Module Overview
<p>Students will learn a variety of production management techniques by breaking down a script for production. They will develop a detailed schedule and other documentation to enable the script to be produced/delivered.</p>
